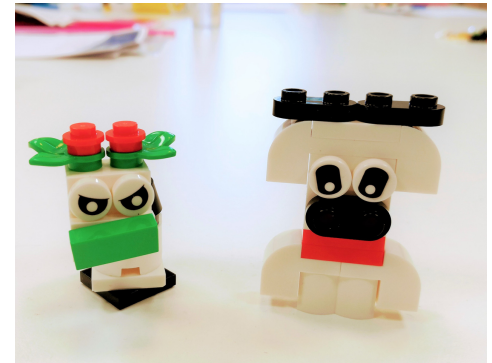


Box of Blocks! – BONUS

The 'eyes' have it!



This White Classic box was released in 2021 and offers some good flexibility in usage because it comes with more eye than the other classic boxes, meaning learners are able to identify it with animated builds. Here's just two ways to use it...

Introductions

I've often used Mini Figures when asking learners to introduce themselves, but you need LOTS of them to allow for choice. This little box is a great alternative. Simply ask your learners to introduce themselves using the Lego bricks.

They can either choose one of the three suggested mini builds (with the instructions) or free flow with any of the bricks. Giving them the option to build from instructions works really well for those who either don't feel confidence in exploring abstract forms, or for those who really enjoy structure. Ask the to share their build with an explanation.

Outcomes

After an activity ask your learners to build the outcome. This can work well if an outcome is personal, but also if a team has agreed on the same outcome, ask them to build the it individually... you'll find everyone has a slightly different version of what the outcome is. This is great for clarifying and moving forwards
